Birds names and their meanings

ATHENÉ - The scientific name for a Little Owl and the Public defender Lawyer.

BLUEY - A Blue Tit and named after a good 'travelling' friend of the author.

BRUNO - A Buzzard and named after German for Brown.

CAW - A Crow and named after their call.

CHOUCAS - The Sheriff and the French name for a Crow.

COCKY - The leader of the Sparrow's and named after his attitude.

COLUMBUS - Adapted from Columba the Scientific name for a pigeon.

FLASH - A Pheasant and named after his displaying of his coloured plummage.

FRIN - Abbreviation of Fringella the scientific name for a Chaffinch.

GRAND DUC - The owner of the wood and the French name for an Eagle Owl.

J - The Judge and the phonetic sound of a Jay.

JACK - The Mayor, a Jackdaw and with his partner, Jill, named after the nursery rhyme.

JILL - A Jackdaw, Jack's partner and community nurse.

LINNE - A Chaffinch and named after the Swedish scientist and his classification system.

LUSCINIA - Nicknamed Gobby after Gobbemouche, French slang for a Nightingale.

MADGE - North country dialect for a Magpie and the prosecuting Lawyer.

MARTIN - Named after French for a Kingfisher.

MERLE - Scottish for Blackbird and the community Undertaker.

PERSEY - A Blue Tit and named after PERSE the name for a type of Indigo Blue.

PIP - Abbreviation of Pippin and the smallest bird in the wood.

SAPPHIRE - A Blue Tit and Persey's sister. Named after her lighter Blue head.

WOODY - A Woodpecker and named after the cartoon character Woody Woodpecker.
